Dear parents, Next week is busy with our Remembrance Service on Monday at 10:20am (parents and family members are warmly invited to join us for this short service), followed by parent consultations on Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons/evenings. I will be in the hall to answer any questions or for a chat. I am aware that some children will need to be in school during your consultation due to childcare issues. If your children have alternative arrangements, please do not bring them into school. However, if you have no childcare, your children are welcome but please remember that they are your responsibility and they will be expected to sit with you – or in the library where we'll have paper and pencils for quiet drawing.

Looking ahead, please save the date of Friday, 6th December. FOWPS will be holding their Christmas Crafts Afternoon from 3:30 – 4:30pm. That will be followed by Supper with Santa and a visit to the grotto. This was a hugely popular event last year and we're building on our success.
